The Maryland State Commission on Criminal Sentencing Policy (MSCCSP) oversees the state's voluntary sentencing guidelines for criminal cases prosecuted in circuit court. Using data collected from the Maryland sentencing guidelines worksheets, the MSCCSP monitors circuit court sentencing practice and adopts changes to the guidelines consistent with legislative intent when necessary.
