Below is a breakdown of the \$10 million awarded to Prince George's County from the Attorney General's Mortgage Settlement:

\$2 million	Emergency assistance to families who have fallen behind on their
	mortgage payments due to no fault of their own. This may include
	sudden loss of income usually loss of job. Another requirement is that
	the amount to catch up or cure is no more than \$10,000 and the family
	can sustain the mortgage payments once the emergency assistance
	has been rendered.
\$2 million	Assistance to 1st time home buyers in the form of a down payment
	and closing cost assistance to purchase homes, particularly in the
	areas that had the highest incidence of foreclosure
\$6 million	Funds were used to partner with the MD-DHCD (Maryland Department
	of Housing and Community Development) for its Maryland Mortgage
	Program. With this program, Prince George's County was able to
	leverage \$100 Million in mortgage loans to make grant awards in the
	amount of \$10,000 to home buyers purchasing homes in 14 County
	zip codes.
